User's guide for eMedCheck for Palm PDA

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User's guide for eMedCheck

1) Loading the Program

- Go to **Applications** and click on **eMedCheck** (it must be present if it was installed properly, else follow the instructions in the “eMedCheck Installation Guide” to re-install the software).
- Now you may either choose to enter the data for a household (Go to Step 2) or verify the data saved in the database. To view the records, please hit the **View Records** button.

2) Input Patient's Last Name

- Tap at the center of the screen on the dotted lines.
- Type patient's last name using key pad
- Click on **Next** after typing the last name.
 - o Note: The minimum characters for the last name should be 2 characters otherwise the software gives an error indicating short last name.

3) Answer Previous Vaccination Time

- Answer whether or not the previous vaccination is less than 6 months. Click **Yes** or **No**.
- Based on the answer which in **Yes** or **No**, next screen will appear. If the answer is Yes, the patient will be referred to the Nurse or Primary Physician or if the answer is No further questions will be asked.

4) Answer Current Status of the Patient

- Answer whether or not the patient is sick today or has any allergies. Click **Yes** or **No**.
- Based on the answer which in **Yes** or **No**, next screen will appear. If the answer is Yes, the patient will be referred to the Nurse or Primary Physician or if the answer is No further questions will be asked.

5) Answer Patient's Sex

- Answer patient's sex, If the patients is female additional questions regarding pregnancy will be asked. Choose **Male** or **Female**.
 - o Note: If sex is male, vaccine will be prescribed for the patient.

5) Answer Women additional question

- Answer whether the female patient is pregnant or there is a chance to get pregnant. Click **Yes** or **No**.
- If patient is pregnant or there is a chance, she will be referred to Nurse or Primary

Physician otherwise vaccine will be prescribed.
